Maya at the Pond

- ① On Saturday, Maya visited a pond near her town. She saw a beaver carry a branch through the water. The beaver's flat tail slapped the pond, making a loud sound. Maya wanted to observe what happened next.
- ② A beaver lives in a habitat that gives it food, water, and shelter. At the pond, the beaver used its sharp teeth to gnaw wood. It stacked sticks and mud to build a dam across a small stream.
- ③ Maya wrote notes in her journal. She explained that the dam can slow water and make a deeper pond. Then she compared the beaver's work to people building a wall to hold back water.
