UN- IS A PREFIX

At the beginning of some words, un- means not or the opposite. It changes the meaning of the root word.

unknown means not known.

UN- IS NOT A PREFIX

Some words begin with the letters un, but un- does not mean not or opposite. The letters are just part of the word.

1	unhappy	PREFIX	un- means not, so unhappy means not happy.
2	unwrap	PREFIX	un- means do the opposite, so unwrap means take off a wrapping.
3	uncle	NO PREFIX	The letters un do not mean not or opposite in uncle.
4	unfair	PREFIX	un- means not, so unfair means not fair.
5	under	NO PREFIX	The letters un do not mean not or opposite in under.
6	until	NO PREFIX	The letters un do not mean not or opposite in until.
7	unlock	PREFIX	un- means do the opposite, so unlock means open a lock.
