A Feeder for the Library

1	What does the writer want Principal Lee to do?	Put a bird feeder by the library window.
2	Who is the writer trying to convince? What words show this?	The writer is trying to convince Principal Lee. The words "Dear Principal Lee" show this.
3	How might the reason about rainy days help convince Principal Lee?	It shows that students can enjoy watching birds indoors even when it is rainy, so the feeder would be useful.
