### Caring for a Goldfish

- ① Goldfish need a clean home. Put your fish bowl away from sunny windows. Bright sun can warm the water too much. A small filter helps keep the water clear. Does your bowl have a filter?
- ② Feed your goldfish a small pinch of fish food once or twice a day. Too much food can make the water dirty. Watch your fish swim to the top. Is it looking for food? Give only what it can eat quickly.
- ③ Each week, move some old water out and add clean water. Use a cup that is only for the fish bowl. Never use soap on the cup. Your careful steps help your goldfish stay healthy.
