The Garden Meeting

- ① On Tuesday, Ms. Chen's class will meet in garden groups. Each group will plan where to plant bean seeds. Before the meeting, Jada reads the garden map. She brings her notebook, a pencil, and one idea about sunny spots.
- ② Jada also thinks of a question. She writes, "Will the hose reach the far bed?" At the meeting, she listens while Omar shares his idea. Then Jada asks her question and uses the map to explain her sunny spot.
- ③ Omar has a different plan. He brings a picture of a rain barrel and tells the group it can collect water. Jada says, "I have an idea to add." The group takes turns, chooses a plan, and writes jobs.
