The Water Poster

- ① Four students, Mia, Omar, June, and Eli, planned a poster about saving water. First, they chose group norms: use kind words, listen when someone talks, and share supplies. Their goal was to make a clear poster by Friday.
- ② Next, they made a procedure. Mia would draw a faucet, Omar would write tips about saving water, June would color the pictures, and Eli would check that the words were easy to read. They put the steps in order on a list.
- ③ During work time, Omar asked before using June's crayons. Eli noticed that the title was hard to see, so the group chose darker letters. When Mia finished her drawing, she helped June color. Each person completed a job, and the poster was ready Friday.
