A Garden for Bees

- ① Mia, Ben, and Omar wanted to help bees near their school. They chose to make a small flower garden. First, they sat together and talked about what bees need. Mia wrote each idea on a chart.
- ② Ben wondered which flowers would grow well in their sunny space. The group looked in a library book and found that sunflowers and zinnias need lots of sun. Omar drew a plan with rows, paths, and places for signs.
- ③ Next, the friends shared jobs. Mia made signs that said, "Please watch for bees." Ben measured the garden space. Omar planted seeds with a teacher. They checked one another's work and changed the paths so people could walk safely.
