- ② Luis drew a plan with a shallow bowl and smooth stones. Maya wrote a list of supplies. Chen checked the garden map and chose a spot away from the walking path. They listened while each person explained an idea.
- ③ At first, the bowl tipped on the uneven ground. The team stopped and looked at the problem together. Chen suggested placing flat bricks under the bowl. Everyone agreed, and Luis tested it. Then Maya filled the bowl with clean water.
