Two Garden Messages

- ① Ms. Lee planned a Saturday garden workday. Families could come to help plant seeds and pull weeds. Students would also hear about the workday at school. Ms. Lee chose different messages because families and classmates needed different information.
- ② Dear Families, Our Garden Workday is this Saturday from 9:00 to 11:00. Please attend and help plant seeds or pull weeds. Bring gloves if you have them. Tell Ms. Lee by Thursday if you can come.
- ③ On Friday, Ms. Lee told the class, “Our garden workday is tomorrow morning. Your families are invited to attend and help. Please take this note home.” The short school announcement gave classmates only the information they needed to share.
