- ① At library time, Maya picked a book about tide pools. She looked at the cover, read the first page, and decided it was a good fit. She put a bookmark in it so she could read more tomorrow.
- ② One part had a new word, anemone. Maya read the sentence again and used the picture to help. She did not know the word at first, but she kept reading and learned that an anemone is an ocean animal.
- ③ After reading, Maya opened her notebook. She wrote, "I want to visit a tide pool because I might see anemones." Then she checked her sentence. She added a period and drew a tiny star beside her favorite idea.
