From Seed to Sprout

- ① A bean seed can grow into a new plant. First, the seed takes in water from the soil. Its outer coat softens and cracks. A tiny root begins to push down into the soil.
- ② Next, the root grows longer and holds the young plant in place. The seed uses food stored inside it. Soon, a small shoot pushes up through the soil and reaches toward light.
- ③ Then, leaves open on the shoot. The leaves use sunlight, air, and water to make food for the plant. Finally, the plant grows taller and makes more leaves. It no longer needs food from the seed.
