Three Ways Seeds Travel

- ① **Wind:** Some seeds have light fluff or wings. Wind can lift them and carry them away from the parent plant. A dandelion seed floats like a tiny parachute. Maple seeds spin as they fall.
- ② **Water:** Some plants grow near ponds, streams, or oceans. Their seeds can float until water carries them to a new place. Coconuts have a thick outer covering that helps them float across ocean water.
- ③ **Animals:** Burrs have tiny hooks that catch on animal fur. Other seeds are inside fruits. After an animal eats the fruit, it may drop the seeds far from the plant. This helps new plants grow.
