### A Turtle's Journey

- ① On a warm summer night, baby sea turtles hatch beneath the sand. They use their flippers to climb up together. When they reach the beach, moonlight shining on the water helps guide them toward the ocean.
- ② In the water, the hatchlings swim away from the shore. Near the surface, they may find floating seaweed. The seaweed gives them a place to hide from some hungry fish while they grow stronger.
- ③ Years later, a grown female may return to a beach near where she hatched. She digs a hole in the sand and lays eggs. Then she covers the nest and goes back to the sea.
