Nia's Windy Kite

- ① On Saturday, Nia brought her red kite to the park. Dark clouds moved over the trees, but a steady wind filled the kite's cloth. Nia held the string tight as the kite rose above the grass.
- ② A hard gust pulled the string from Nia's hand. The kite flew toward a tall oak tree and caught on a low branch. Nia looked at the branch, then hurried to find the park gardener.
- ③ The gardener brought a long pole and gently lifted the kite free. Nia thanked her and checked the string for knots. Then the clouds opened, and rain began to fall, so Nia packed her kite away.

#	QUESTION	ANSWER
1	After paragraph 1, what might you predict the wind will do to Nia's kite? Use one detail from the paragraph.	The wind might pull or carry the kite away. A steady wind fills the kite's cloth as it rises.
2	After the kite catches on the branch, what is likely to happen next? Why?	The gardener will likely help get the kite down because Nia goes to find the gardener and the kite is on a low branch.
3	How does paragraph 3 show that the prediction about the gardener was correct?	The gardener uses a long pole to lift the kite free.

PART 3 • YOUR TURN (SAMPLE ANSWER)

Leo saw muddy paw prints by the open gate, and he heard a bark behind the shed. I predicted that his dog was hiding there. My prediction came true when Leo found his dog behind the shed.

Accept reasonable predictions that use details from the passage, even if students use different words. For the open task, check for two clues, a prediction based on those clues, and an outcome that clearly tracks the prediction.
