YOUR JOB Underline Maya's purpose. Circle her target audience, then write 1, 2, and 3 beside her three writing goals. These details show how she plans writing for her readers.

Maya Plans a Flyer

- ① On Friday, Maya will make a flyer about the class book swap. She wants students to bring books they have finished. Her target audience is the children in her second-grade class, so she plans to use clear, friendly words.
- ② Before writing, Maya makes three goals. She will tell the date and place, explain what students should bring, and ask them to share. She checks that each goal helps her classmates know what to do at the swap.
- ③ Maya chooses a large title, "Book Swap Friday!" Then she adds the room number and a short list. She does not use hard words or tiny print. Her choices match her purpose, goals, and audience.
