Mina Plans a Seed Story

- ① Mina wanted to write about how a seed grows. First, she thought about what she already knew. She remembered planting bean seeds in a cup. She knew that seeds need water and that a tiny plant can push up through soil.
- ② Next, Mina read a library book about seeds. She learned that roots grow down into the soil. Roots take in water. Mina wrote “roots grow down” on her idea page because it was a new fact from the book.
- ③ Then Mina talked with her grandpa, who gardens. He told her that some seeds are carried by wind. Mina added a question: “Which seeds fly in the wind?” Now she had ideas from her memory, a text, and a talk.
