Maya Revises a Notice

- ① Maya wrote a class notice about the garden. Her first draft said, “Our garden needs help. Come on Friday.” Ms. Lee said readers needed the time, place, and jobs. Maya read her draft again and planned changes.
- ② Maya put the most important facts first. She added, “Garden Helpers, Friday at 3:00, behind the school.” Then she told what to do: pull weeds, carry water, and plant seeds. These details made her notice clearer.
- ③ Ms. Lee also said that “Come on” sounded plain. Maya changed it to “Join us!” and drew a small flower beside the title. Her new notice gave useful facts, used lively words, and caught readers’ eyes.
