- ② Pops told Lina that many Chinese families celebrate Lunar New Year at the start of a new lunar calendar year. At home, they swept the floor before dinner. Later, relatives shared a meal and gave children red envelopes.
- ③ That evening, Lina watched a parade move down Grant Avenue. Drums boomed, and dancers lifted a long dragon puppet. Lina understood that this joyful day connected her family to Chinese traditions from long ago.
