Garden Messages

- ① At the school garden, Maya sees a printed sign that says, “Water the seedlings.” The sign is print because the message uses written words on paper. A picture of a blue watering can is visual communication.
- ② Later, Maya watches a tablet video showing how roots grow. This is digital communication because it uses an electronic device. A bell rings three times to tell students that garden club is starting. The bell sound is auditory communication.
- ③ Maya’s teacher tells her, “Pick the red tomatoes.” This is spoken communication because a person says the message aloud. A garden poster has words, arrows, and pictures together. The poster is multimodal because it uses more than one way to share information.

2	In paragraph 2, what mode is the tablet video? What mode is the bell sound?	The tablet video is digital communication. The bell sound is auditory communication.
3	Why is the garden poster multimodal?	It uses words, arrows, and pictures, which are more than one way to share information.
