**YOUR JOB** Underline Maya's research question, circle the two sources she used, and number the two facts in her report 1 and 2. This shows how she found and shared accurate information.

### Maya Studies Monarchs

- ① Maya wondered, "How do monarch butterflies know when to fly south?" She wrote her question in a notebook. Then she looked for answers in a library book and on a museum website about monarchs.
- ② The book said monarchs use the Sun to help guide their flight. The museum website explained that cooler days and less sunlight help signal that it is time to migrate. Maya checked whether both sources agreed.
- ③ Both sources said monarchs travel to warmer places in fall. Maya wrote, "Monarchs migrate when days grow cooler. They use the Sun to help guide their flight." She named the book and website so readers could check her facts.

**PART 3 • YOUR TURN (SAMPLE ANSWER)**

Question: What helps monarchs know when and where to fly? The museum website says cooler days and less sunlight signal monarchs to migrate. The library book says monarchs use the Sun to help guide their flight.

Accept a new, answerable question about monarch migration and a two-sentence response with accurate information from both named sources. The student may use different wording if the book fact is about the Sun and the website fact is about cooler days and less sunlight.
