Busy Beavers

- ① Beavers live near streams and ponds. Their large front teeth cut small trees and branches. Beavers carry the wood to the water. They use mud, sticks, and stones to build dams across slow-moving streams.
- ② A dam slows the water behind it and can make a deeper pond. In the deeper pond, a beaver can build a lodge, which is its home. The water around the lodge can help keep some animals away.
- ③ Beavers also use their flat tails while they work. A tail helps a beaver swim and steer in water. When a beaver feels danger, it may slap its tail on the water. The loud sound warns nearby beavers.
