A Message in Motion

- ① On a warm morning, Maya watched honey bees visit the flowers near her porch. One bee returned to the hive with yellow pollen on its legs. Inside, the bee moved in a small figure-eight pattern. This movement is called a waggle dance. It gives other bees clues about where to find food for the colony.
- ② The direction of the dance can show the direction of the flowers. The angle of the bee's path relates to the sun. A straight-up path means the food is in the same direction as the sun. A longer waggle can tell bees that the food is farther away. Bees use this message quickly each day.
- ③ A bee does not need to speak or carry a map. Its dance shares useful details with the hive. After watching the dancer, other worker bees may fly out to search. They use the dance along with their sense of smell and their memory of the area. This teamwork helps the colony collect nectar for food.
