Planting Day

- ① Before the spring plant sale, Maya and her uncle prepared a small garden bed behind the community center. They used a ruler to measure rows and a marker to label each seed spot. Maya carefully unpacked bean seeds from a paper packet. She noticed that some seeds were round, while others were speckled. A watering can waited nearby.
- ② On planting day, Maya reread the directions before she began. The guide said to place each bean under the soil and keep the ground moist, not muddy. Her uncle explained that a seed coat protects the tiny plant inside. Maya was a careful helper, so she worked slowly. When a row looked uneven, she replanted one seed.
- ③ After one week, green shoots appeared above the soil. Maya checked the bed each morning and removed weeds that could crowd the young plants. She wrote a short report for the center's newsletter. In it, she described the seedlings as hopeful signs of spring. Her family planned to return, water the garden, and reuse the ruler at the next workday.
