Beavers at Work

- ① At dawn, a beaver swims across a quiet pond. Its flat tail steers it past reeds and stones. The beaver carries a green branch to its lodge, a home made from sticks and mud. Near the shore, it chews wood with strong teeth. A beaver can close its ears and nose while it dives below water.
- ② Beavers are busy builders. They pile logs and rocks in a stream to make a dam. The dam slows the water and can form a deep pool. This pool gives the animals a safe place to rest. In winter, the lodge may be covered by ice, but the beavers stay warm inside with stored food.
- ③ One evening, a child watches a beaver drag a leafy twig. Splash, the beaver slips beneath the water. The child sees bubbles rise near the dam, then hears a soft scrape on the bank. Soon, moonlight shines on the pond. The child walks home, thinking about the clever animal and its careful work by night.
