TWO IDEAS CONNECTED

A subordinating conjunction is a joining word, like because, if, when, or although. It connects two complete ideas to make a complete sentence.

Since the sun set, Omar lit a lantern.

NEEDS ANOTHER IDEA

A joining word is there, but it does not connect two complete ideas. The reader is left waiting to hear what happens.

While the rabbit hid under a bush.

1	After the game ended, Dad drove us home.	CONNECTED	After joins the idea that the game ended with the complete idea that Dad drove home.
2	Because I forgot my lunch.	NEEDS MORE	Because starts a joining word phrase, but the sentence does not tell what happened because of the forgotten lunch.
3	We will paint the sign when the shop opens.	CONNECTED	When joins the complete ideas about painting the sign and the shop opening.
4	Although the puppy was small, it barked loudly.	CONNECTED	Although joins the idea that the puppy was small with the complete idea that it barked loudly.
5	If the cookies are ready.	NEEDS MORE	If starts a joining word phrase, but the sentence does not tell what will happen if the cookies are ready.
6	Before the movie began.	NEEDS MORE	Before starts a joining word phrase, but the sentence does not tell what happened before the movie began.
7	I wore boots because the path was muddy.	CONNECTED	Because joins the complete ideas about wearing boots and the muddy path.
8	When the wind slowed, the kite rose again.	CONNECTED	When joins the idea that the wind slowed with the complete idea that the kite rose again.

PART 3 • MAKE YOUR OWN (SAMPLE ANSWERS)

- **CONNECTED:** Although the soup was hot, Lena took a small sip.
- **NEEDS MORE:** Because the train was late.

Challenge: If the clouds clear, we will see the stars.

Sort answers: 1 CONNECTED, 2 NEEDS MORE, 3 CONNECTED, 4 CONNECTED, 5 NEEDS MORE, 6 NEEDS MORE, 7 CONNECTED, 8 CONNECTED. In Part 2, students should explain whether the joining word connects two complete ideas or leaves the sentence needing another idea.
