COMPOUND SENTENCE

A compound sentence has two complete sentences joined by a joining word, such as and, but, or so.

The acrobat spun, and the audience clapped.

COMPLEX SENTENCE

A complex sentence has one complete sentence and one part that cannot stand alone. It often uses words such as because, when, or if.

After the bell rang, everyone hurried outside.
