Mila at the Nature Center

- ① On Saturday, Mila visited a nature center with her uncle. Near the door, a sign said, “Please observe, or watch carefully, the pond animals.” Mila knew observe because the sign gave a short meaning after the comma. She looked for frogs, beetles, and tiny water skaters. Her uncle handed her a trail map with symbols for paths, restrooms, and picnic tables.
- ② At the turtle tank, Mila read a card that used the word camouflage. The card explained that camouflage helps an animal blend in with its surroundings. Mila then checked the center's small field guide. In the guide's glossary, she found shell. It said a shell is a hard outer covering that protects some animals. Pictures helped her connect the words to what she saw.
- ③ Later, Mila heard a worker call an owl nocturnal. She used nearby words to guess that nocturnal meant active at night, since the worker said the owl rests during the day. To be sure, Mila used a dictionary on a tablet. The entry confirmed her idea and gave a sentence with nocturnal. Mila learned that clues and reference books can work together.
