A Bean Plant's Life

- ① First, a dry bean seed is placed in moist soil. Water moves through its seed coat, and the seed swells. Inside the seed is a tiny baby plant and stored food. Next, the coat splits, and a small root grows downward. The root takes in water and minerals and helps hold the young plant in the soil.
- ② Then, a shoot grows upward and reaches the soil surface. Two small seed leaves open and catch sunlight. The leaves use sunlight, air, and water to make food, so the stored food from the seed is no longer needed. After that, more leaves grow. Roots spread farther, bringing in water and helping the plant stay upright.
- ③ Finally, a mature bean plant can grow flowers. Pollen must reach the flower's female part for a bean pod to form. The pod develops where the flower was and holds new seeds. The pod dries, and the seeds become ready for planting. A gardener can place one of those seeds in moist soil to begin the cycle again.
