### The Dry Garden

- ① On Saturday, Lena arrived at the community garden with a box of bean seeds. The garden club planned to plant them before noon. But the soil was dry and hard, and the water barrel was empty. Lena noticed dark clouds gathering above the library. She remembered that rainwater ran from the library roof into a large collection tank.
- ② Lena hurried to the tank and found a spout near its bottom. She turned the handle, but only a few drops came out. Then she saw a twist in the long hose that led from the tank to the garden beds. Lena called her friend Omar, who was carrying a small hand shovel. Together, they pulled the hose straight.
- ③ Water rushed through the hose and soaked the hard soil. Lena and Omar planted the bean seeds in neat rows just before the first raindrops fell. The club leader thanked them for checking the problem instead of giving up. Lena looked at the cloudy sky and wondered whether the new beans would soon push green leaves above the ground.

- 1 After paragraph 1, what is most likely to happen next? Use one detail from the paragraph to support your prediction.

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- 2 At first, Lena may predict that water will flow from the spout. What new detail in paragraph 2 should make her change that prediction?

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- 3 After paragraph 2, what is likely to happen when Lena and Omar pull the hose straight? Why?

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- 4 What does Lena predict about the bean seeds at the end of the passage? Which detail supports her prediction?

| 4 | What does Lena predict about the bean seeds at the end of the passage? Which detail supports her prediction?                           | <b>She predicts that green leaves will soon grow above the ground. The seeds were planted in soaked soil, and rain began to fall.</b>           |
