A Butterfly Garden

- ① On Saturday, maya visited the community garden with her uncle. They planted milkweed, asters, and goldenrod near the fence. These plants give monarch butterflies places to lay eggs and drink nectar. Maya carried a small trowel, gloves, and a watering can. After planting, she said "I hope the butterflies find this garden soon" Her uncle smiled and nodded.
- ② Monarch caterpillars eat milkweed leaves, but adult monarchs sip nectar from many flowers. A garden needs sunny spots, shallow water, and blooms that open at different times. maya's uncle placed smooth stones in a dish of water. Butterflies can land on the stones while they drink. He also hung a sign that read, "Please stay on the path" This helps protect the young plants.
- ③ Before they left, Maya checked the soil. It felt dry, so she poured water slowly around each plant's roots. Her uncle reminded her not to pull leaves from the milkweed. Caterpillars need those leaves for food. maya wrote three notes in her garden journal: "Water the plants," "Watch for eggs," and "Look for butterflies." At home she drew a picture of the new garden.
