Pine Creek Cleanup Notice

- ① Calling all students and families near Pine Creek! On Saturday, May 9, the Riverbank Clean Team will meet at 9:00 a.m. by the library bridge. Bring work gloves, a water bottle, and an adult if you are under 12. The team will provide trash bags and safety vests. Check in at the blue table before walking to the creek with your group.
- ② Trash can wash from the creek into the lake after heavy rain. It can harm fish, turtles, and birds that mistake small pieces for food. Last spring, volunteers filled 18 bags with litter from this path. Picking up trash helps keep the water and trail safer for animals and people who visit there each week.
- ③ Join the clean team and help fill fewer bags this spring. Ask a family member to come with you, then meet us at the blue table at 9:00. Volunteers will work in small groups and return by noon for a snack. Your help can make the path cleaner for everyone who uses it during the busy weekend.
