Beavers Build Homes

- ① Beavers are busy builders. Since they need deep water to stay safe, they build dams across small streams. A dam can slow the water and make a pond. Beavers use branches, mud, and stones, so the dam holds back water. Although a dam looks simple, it can change the home for many animals living there.
- ② A beaver's pond can help some neighbors. Fish may find calmer water in the pond. Frogs can lay eggs near its edge, and ducks may rest there. However, a dam may flood some land. People sometimes move a dam because water can cover a path or a field. When this happens, workers choose a safe way to help the water flow.
- ③ Beavers keep working in winter, but they do not go outside much. Their pond may freeze on top. They swim under the ice and eat branches stored near their home. Also, deep water gives them space to move. Although winter is cold, the pond helps beavers live safely until spring returns to the forest again.
