Beaver Builders

- ① Beavers use their bodies and building skills to make safe homes near water. They are mammals that live near ponds, streams, and rivers. Their flat tails help them swim and balance on land. Beavers have webbed back feet for paddling. They use sharp front teeth to cut small trees and branches. These body parts help beavers gather food and build lodges.
- ② Dams Change Water Beavers pile sticks, mud, and rocks across moving water to make a dam. A dam slows the water and can form a pond. The deeper pond helps protect beavers from animals that hunt them. It also gives them a place to store branches for winter food under the water near their homes.
- ③ Lodges Are Homes Beavers build homes called lodges beside or inside ponds. A lodge may have walls of branches and mud. The entrance is usually underwater, which makes it harder for many predators to get inside. In winter, beavers stay in the lodge and eat branches they stored earlier. By building dams and lodges, beavers shape the places where they live.
