A Birdhouse Repair

- ① After a windy night, Maya found that the small birdhouse near the school garden was unsafe. One side had come loose, and rain could get into the nest space. She asked the garden club for help. The group agreed to rebuild the birdhouse before spring. They planned a careful fix so birds could use it again.
- ② Maya took away a few broken pieces. She was not careless, so she wore gloves and kept nails in a cup. Next, the club measured a new board and attached it firmly. Their teacher explained that a sturdy birdhouse gives young birds a dry place during storms. Everyone worked quietly because the nesting area needed protection.
- ③ When the work was finished, the birdhouse looked colorful and strong. Maya felt excitement when a wren inspected the roof from a nearby branch. The club posted a sign that asked visitors not to disturb nests. Later, Maya reread the sign and checked the birdhouse. Her helpful actions made the garden a safer place for wildlife.
