Busy Beaver Builders

- ① Beavers are busy builders that live near ponds and streams. At night, a beaver may carry leafy branches to the water. It uses its wide, flat tail to steer and to warn other beavers of danger. Its sharp teeth can cut through wood, helping it gather pieces for a strong home beside the bank safely.
- ② A beaver's home is called a lodge. The lodge can have an underwater entrance, which helps keep the animal safe from many predators. Inside, the beaver makes a dry room above the waterline. A family may share this shelter through the winter, when ice covers the pond and food is harder to reach each cold day.
- ③ To build a dam, beavers pile stones, sticks, and mud across moving water. The barrier slows the stream and creates a deeper pond. A quiet pond gives the animals room to swim, store food, and raise their young. Beavers also repair weak spots, so their homes can last through heavy rain or melting snow in spring.
