### Maya's Water Research

- ① Maya's class was starting a unit about how cities use water. Maya liked drawing maps, and she wondered where rain goes after it falls on streets. For her class project, she needed information about storm drains, rivers, and ways people keep water clean. She visited the school library with a notebook and a list of questions.
- ② First, Maya chose a photo book called Rainy-Day City Maps. Its street pictures helped her study a topic she enjoyed, but it had few facts about clean water. Next, she found a library book, Storm Drains and Streams. It explained how drains carry rainwater and how trash can reach rivers. Maya wrote its title on her project list because it answered two of her questions.
- ③ At home, Maya read a short article on a city website called Keeping Litter Out of Drains. The article gave facts from her town, including a reminder not to sweep leaves into storm drains. She selected it because local examples would make her project more useful. Maya also planned to write a map caption that showed a rain drop's path from a street to a river.
