A Beaver's Home

- ① At dusk, a beaver starts building a dam across a narrow stream. It uses its sharp front teeth to cut small trees and branches. The beaver drags the wood through shallow water and piles it in the stream. Mud, stones, and plants fill gaps between the branches. Soon, the wall slows the water behind it.
- ② The pond created by the dam gives the beaver a place to build a lodge. The beaver carries more sticks to the pond's edge and makes its home. A lodge may have a room above the waterline and an underwater entrance. The entrance helps the beaver stay safer from many land animals, which cannot easily reach it by swimming.
- ③ A beaver cares for its pond and lodge throughout the year. During winter, the pond may freeze on top, but water remains below the ice. Inside the lodge, the beaver rests and eats stored branches. In spring, fast-moving water or fallen trees can damage the dam. The beaver repairs weak places so the pond and lodge remain useful.
