Peregrines Above the City

- ① High above busy streets, peregrine falcons often make homes on tall buildings. A cliff-nesting bird, a peregrine can use a window ledge or bridge tower like a rocky cliff. Cities also provide pigeons and other birds for food. These hunters dive through the air to catch prey, sometimes reaching more than 200 miles per hour during a hunting dive.
- ② In spring, female peregrines lay eggs in a shallow nest scrape. On a building, the scrape may be placed in a protected box filled with gravel. Both parents take turns keeping the eggs warm. After the chicks hatch, adults bring food to the nest. A box with a low edge helps keep young chicks from falling before they can fly.
- ③ Some city workers and bird groups watch known nest sites from a distance. If a nest is on a building, workers may delay noisy repairs until the young falcons leave. Volunteers also record when eggs hatch and when chicks first fly. Their notes help scientists learn which nest sites are used again in later years.
