Maya's Tide Pool Notes

- ① On Saturday morning, Maya visited a rocky tide pool with her uncle. At first, the pool looked still. Then she saw a small crab slide under a ledge. Purple sea stars clung to wet rocks, and green sea lettuce waved in the water. Maya wrote each discovery in her field notebook before the tide rose.
- ② Near the edge, Maya noticed an anemone. Its soft tentacles opened like a flower, but the animal stayed attached to the rock. Her uncle explained that tide-pool animals need damp places to live. Maya carefully stepped around the pool so she would not disturb the shells, algae, or tiny animals hiding there nearby.
- ③ Before leaving, Maya copied a short reminder into her notebook: "Look closely, touch nothing, and return rocks to their places." She wanted to share the rule with her class. Back at school, she used her notes to make a sign for the science table. The sign helped visitors remember that a tide pool is a small habitat, not a toy.
