A Garden for Pollinators

- ① Ms. Chen's class planned a pollinator garden beside the school library. Their shared goal was to create a space that would help bees and butterflies and teach younger students about native plants. First, the class listed jobs, including researching plants, measuring the plot, drawing signs, and asking the principal for permission to use the space.
- ② At the first meeting, Maya said the group should choose plants that grow well in their area. Omar had found a website with a native-plant list, so he shared it with everyone. The team compared the list with the amount of sunlight near the library. They agreed on three plants after each member explained a reason for a choice.
- ③ During the next week, the researchers gave the writers plant facts for the signs. The artists showed their sketches before making final copies, and classmates suggested clearer labels. When rain delayed planting, the group changed its schedule and divided the remaining tasks. On planting day, everyone checked the plan, helped where needed, and completed the garden together.
