1	Mr. Bell said, "The gates open at noon."	CORRECT	The attribution comes first and uses a comma before the quoted sentence.
2	"can we borrow the telescope?" asked Priya.	REVISE	The first word of the spoken sentence should begin with a capital letter.
3	"Hold the rope" said Eli.	REVISE	A comma is needed before the attribution, inside the quotation marks.
4	"Pack your map," said Omar.	CORRECT	The statement has a capital letter, quotation marks, and a comma before the attribution.
5	"Where is the trail?" asked Lena.	CORRECT	The question mark is inside the quotation marks, followed by the attribution.
6	"Watch out!" called Rosa.	CORRECT	The exclamation mark is inside the quotation marks, followed by the attribution.
