8	Dad left the keys on the table. Dictionary: table, a list of information in rows and columns.	NO MATCH	Table means a piece of furniture here, not a chart.

- **MATCHES:** Sentence: The seal rested on a rock. Dictionary: seal, a sea animal with flippers. **MATCHES**
- **NO MATCH:** Sentence: We will file the papers by date. Dictionary: file, a tool used to smooth rough edges. **NO MATCH**

Challenge: We sat on the bank to eat lunch. bank: land beside a river. I deposited my coins at the bank. bank: a business that keeps and lends money.
