Write one sentence that uses a hyphenated number-and-unit compound before a noun and an open number-and-unit form after a linking verb.

PART 1 • SORT

#	ITEM	CATEGORY	WHY
1	a three-mile hike	HYPHEN	The number-and-unit compound comes before the noun hike, so it is hyphenated and mile is singular.
2	an eight-hour shift	HYPHEN	The compound comes before the noun shift, so it is hyphenated and hour is singular.
3	The shift lasts eight hours.	OPEN	The number and unit come after the verb lasts, so they stay open and hours is plural.
4	a twenty-minute video	HYPHEN	The compound comes before the noun video, so it is hyphenated and minute is singular.
5	The video is twenty minutes long.	OPEN	The number and unit come after the linking verb is, so they stay open and minutes is plural.
6	The hike is three miles long.	OPEN	The number and unit come after the linking verb is, so they stay open and miles is plural.
7	a five-pound bag	HYPHEN	The compound comes before the noun bag, so it is hyphenated and pound is singular.
8	a two-day trip	HYPHEN	The compound comes before the noun trip, so it is hyphenated and day is singular.

PART 3 • MAKE YOUR OWN (SAMPLE ANSWERS)

- **HYPHEN:** a four-seat canoe
- **OPEN:** The canoe has four seats.

Challenge: Our class planned a two-day visit, but the visit was two days long.

Accept equivalent number-and-unit examples if the hyphenated compound comes before a noun and uses a singular unit. In open forms after verbs, the unit is usually plural when the number is greater than one.
