DEPENDENT CLAUSE

A dependent clause has a subject and a verb, but it does not express a full thought. It needs a complete clause to finish its meaning.

5	because the creek had flooded	DEPENDENT	Because signals that the clause gives a reason but does not finish the thought.
6	whenever the bell rings	DEPENDENT	Whenever signals that the clause needs a complete clause to tell what happens.
7	My cousin fixed the bicycle.	COMPLETE	It has a subject and verb and can stand alone as a sentence.
8	if the trail stays dry	DEPENDENT	If signals that the clause gives a condition and needs a complete clause.
