Tracking a Kelp Mat

- ① At dawn, Maya joined a team on a small research boat off the coast of California. The scientists hoped to track a drifting patch of kelp. Kelp can form broad floating mats that shelter young fish and crabs. Maya watched the green strands rise and fall with each wave. Her job was to record the mat's location every fifteen minutes. A laminated chart helped her compare the boat's position with the coastline. Soon, a thick fog hid the distant cliffs.
- ② After lunch, the fog began to lift, and sunlight warmed the deck. Maya noticed that the kelp mat had drifted south. Near the mat, a seal balanced on a tangled clump of seaweed. It seemed to pose for the camera. Maya took a quick photo, then wrote a detailed record in the team's log. The record listed the time, water temperature, and direction of the current. Her careful notes would help the team compare this trip with later visits.
- ③ Before returning to shore, the crew released a bright orange buoy beside the kelp. A buoy is a floating marker, but the crew needed it to mark this exact patch. The current might carry the mat far from the cliffs by morning. Maya used a handheld radio to report the buoy's number to the lab. On the ride home, she looked at the calm water and wondered what animals would find shelter beneath the moving kelp.

3	In paragraph 2, what does "record" mean in "a detailed record"? What part of speech is it?	Record is a noun meaning a written account or list of information.
4	In paragraph 3, what does the noun "current" mean? How does its job in the sentence help you decide?	Current means moving water. It is the noun doing the action of carrying the kelp mat.
