A definition clue tells what an unfamiliar word means. It may use a meaning phrase set off by commas or words such as means.

A glacier, a huge moving mass of ice, carved the hillside.

CONTRAST CLUE

A contrast clue shows how one idea differs from another. The difference can help you figure out an unfamiliar word.

In contrast to the cheerful parade, the solemn ceremony was quiet and serious.
