### Signal Below

- ① At 6:15, Mara stepped into the closed Northgate station, where a power failure had trapped her younger cousin on the far platform. Her phone flashlight showed three dark tunnels and a wall map covered with route lines. Earlier that day, her class had discussed the ancient Greek myth of Theseus, who entered the Labyrinth to face the Minotaur. Ariadne gave him a thread so he could find his way back. Mara remembered the thread as she listened to water drip somewhere below.
- ② At the stairwell, Mara met Mr. Bell, the station custodian, who handed her a roll of orange survey tape. "Tie it to the rail," he said, "and keep it behind you." A grinding roar came from the service tunnel, where an automatic gate had jammed and swung back and forth. Mara did not enter that tunnel. Instead, she studied the map, followed the tape through a narrow passage, and used her phone to call her cousin. Theo answered from beside a blue emergency cabinet.
- ③ Mara found Theo shivering but unhurt. The cabinet held a hand crank that controlled a loudspeaker, and Mara used it to tell Mr. Bell where they were. He shut off the gate and opened a staff door near the platform. Mara and Theo followed the orange tape back to the stairwell while station workers waited above. Outside, Mara noticed a scrap of tape caught on her sleeve. She folded it into her pocket before the first train replacements arrived.

**PART 3 • YOUR TURN (SAMPLE ANSWER)**

I drew on the medieval Arthur legend. During robotics tryouts, quiet Jalen lifted the heavy practice robot after the older students had failed. The coach asked him to lead the repair team, although Jalen had never wanted attention. Like Arthur pulling the sword from the stone, Jalen's unexpected success reveals a leader whom others had overlooked.

Accept equivalent evidence-based comparisons between the subway journey and the Labyrinth pattern. For theme and message responses, accept reasonable interpretations supported by details about Mara's planning, the tape, communication, or help from Mr. Bell.
