- **FITS:** The desert was arid after months without rain. Arid means very dry.
- **MISFITS:** The mechanic repaired the engine. Repaired means planted seeds.

Challenge: The bat flew out of the cave at dusk. Carlos swung the bat at the baseball. I would use a dictionary to verify both meanings.

For Part 2, students should identify a context clue and explain how a dictionary or reliable online dictionary confirms the meaning. Accept equivalent wording for the definitions when it matches the sentence context.
