HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each set of sounds slowly, then say them again without pauses. Students blend the sounds, circle the matching printed word, or write the word they hear.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE WORDS

SAY “Listen as I say the sounds slowly. Put the sounds together in your head, then circle the word you hear.”
