HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Say bike and bug before beginning. In bike, the vowel is long because it says its letter name, and in bug, the vowel is short.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “Can you listen for the middle vowel sound in each row? Can you circle one word after I ask each question?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Say cat. Which word has the same middle vowel sound: cap, cake, or cup? Circle the word you hear.	cap
b	Say boat. Which word has the same middle vowel sound: hop, rope, or rug? Circle the word you hear.	rope
c	Say tree. Which word has the same middle vowel sound: bed, seed, or sad? Circle the word you hear.	seed

PART 2 • MATCH SOUNDS

SAY “Can you listen as I say the left words, pig, cake, van, and the right words, jam, ship, rain? Can you draw a line from each left word to the right word with the same middle vowel sound?”

- **pig** matches **ship**
- **cake** matches **rain**
- **van** matches **jam**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle-row answers are cap, rope, and seed. Match pig to ship, cake to rain, and van to jam; accept clear circles and lines.
